HOW TO CAST A WRITE-IN VOTE

- STEP 1.** Press the "Write-In" button.
- STEP 2.** An on-screen keyboard appears. Type the name by pressing the buttons on the keyboard. You cannot Write-In any name of a person whose name is already printed on the ballot for the same office.
- STEP 3.** When you are finished, press the OK button. After pressing OK, you are automatically returned to the ballot. To cancel the Write-In, simply press the checkmark, the checkmark will disappear and a new choice can be made.
- NOTE:** Press backspace key (←) at top right of keyboard to make corrections.

HOW TO CAST YOUR VOTES

- STEP 1**
Insert the Voter Card given to you by a poll worker into the yellow-framed slot on the front of the machine.
- STEP 2**
The first page of the official ballot will appear on the screen.
- STEP 3**
To vote for candidates on this ballot, press the circle to the right of your choices. A green checkmark will appear in the circle. (To change a selection, press the checkmark. The checkmark will disappear and a new choice can be made.)
To continue through the ballot, press the **NEXT** arrow in the lower right corner of the screen. The next page of the ballot will be displayed. To review previous pages, press the **BACK** arrow in the lower left corner of the screen.
To review all selections made, press the **REVIEW** button. All of your selections will be displayed. To make a change, press the desired item. The corresponding ballot page will be displayed. Make the necessary changes and press the **RETURN** button to continue.
To vote for a person whose name does NOT appear on this ballot, see **HOW TO CAST A WRITE-IN VOTE** INSTRUCTIONS.
After you have finished making and reviewing all of your choices, press the **DONE** arrow in the lower right corner of the screen on the final page of the ballot.
- STEP 4**
After pressing the **DONE** arrow, the **CAST BALLOT** screen appears. Press the **TOUCH HERE TO CAST YOUR BALLOT** button to finish voting.
- STEP 5**
The voter card will pop out of the yellow framed slot in front of the machine and the **Thank You** Screen will appear. Remove the card and return it to the poll worker.

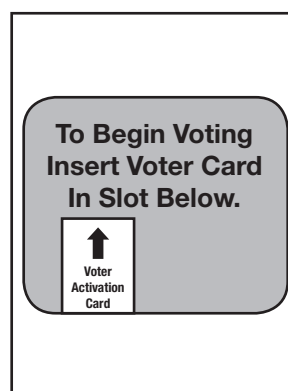

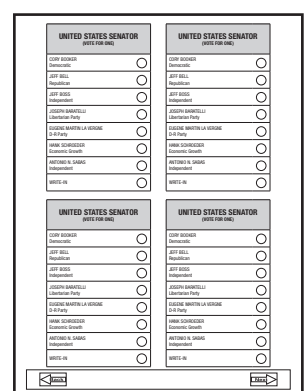
THE VOTING PROCESS

STEP 1



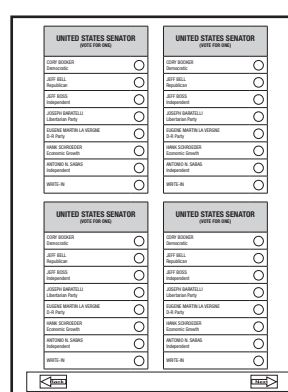
The voter inserts card into the **Yellow Slot** in the front of the machine.

STEP 2



The first page of voter's ballot will appear on screen.

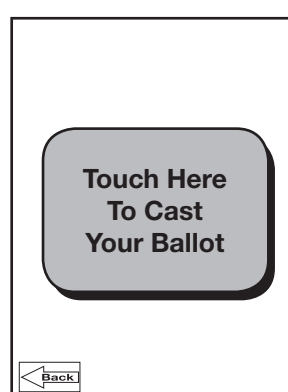
STEP 3



The voter makes a selection by pressing the circle to the right of his/her choice. A green checkmark will appear in the circle. (To change a selection, the voter presses the checkmark. The checkmark will disappear and a new choice can be made.) To continue through the ballot, press the **NEXT** arrow in the lower right corner of the screen.

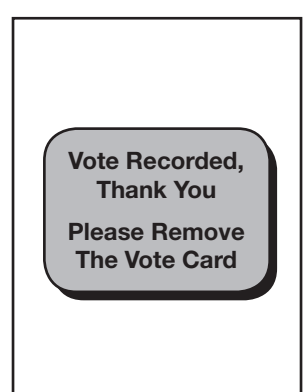
After the voter has finished making and reviewing all of the choices, the voter presses the **"DONE"** arrow in the lower right corner of the screen.

PUBLIC QUESTION NO. 1
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PERMIT CASINO GAMBLING IN TWO COUNTIES OTHER THAN ATLANTIC COUNTY

Do you approve amending the Constitution to permit casino gambling in two additional counties in this State? At present, casino gambling is allowed only in Atlantic City in Atlantic County.

Only one casino in each of the two counties would be permitted. Each casino is to be located in a town that is at least 72 miles from Atlantic City. The amendment would allow certain persons to apply first for a casino license.

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

At present, casino gambling is allowed only in Atlantic City in Atlantic County. This amendment would allow the Legislature to pass laws to permit casino gambling to take place in two other counties in this State.

Only one casino in each of the two counties would be permitted. Each casino is to be located in a town that is at least 72 miles from Atlantic City. The amendment would allow certain persons to apply first for a casino license.

The laws passed by the Legislature would provide for the location and type of casinos and the licensing and taxing of the operation and equipment.

The amendment provides that the State's share of revenue from the operation of the two casinos and of the casinos in Atlantic City would be used for programs and property tax relief for senior citizens and disabled residents. It would also be used for the recovery, stabilization, or improvement of Atlantic City and other purposes as provided by law. Lesser portions would be used to aid the thoroughbred and standardbred horsemen in this State and each town and county in which a casino is located.

PUBLIC QUESTION NO. 2
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO DEDICATE ADDITIONAL REVENUES TO STATE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

Do you approve amending the Constitution to dedicate all revenue from the State motor fuels tax and petroleum products gross receipts tax to the Transportation Trust Fund?

This amendment would provide that an additional three cents of the current motor fuels tax on diesel fuel, which is not dedicated for transportation purposes, be dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund. In doing so, the entire State tax on diesel fuel would be used for transportation purposes. The entire State tax on gasoline is currently dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund and used for transportation purposes.

The amendment would also provide that all of the revenue from the current State tax on petroleum products gross receipts be dedicated to the Transportation Trust Fund. In doing so, the entire State tax on petroleum products gross receipts would be used for transportation purposes.

This amendment does not change the current tax on motor fuels or petroleum products gross receipts.

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

This amendment would dedicate all of the revenue from the State tax on motor fuels to the Transportation Trust Fund. The current dedication is 10.5 cents per gallon on gasoline and diesel fuel. The amendment would include an additional three cents of the tax on diesel fuel that is not currently dedicated. The total revenue from the tax on motor fuels this fiscal year is estimated to be \$541 million.

The amendment also dedicates all of the revenue from the tax on gross receipts of the sale of petroleum products to the Transportation Trust Fund. The current minimum dedication is \$200 million per year. This fiscal year, the revenue from the tax on gross receipts of the sale of petroleum products is estimated to be \$215 million.

The amendment does not change the current tax on motor fuels or petroleum products gross receipts. The dedication to the Transportation Trust Fund ensures that the revenue is only used for transportation purposes.

MUNICIPAL QUESTION NO. 1

Shall the governing body of the Township of Oldmans in the County of Salem, create a "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund", whereby the Township of Oldmans will raise by taxation, a sum of up to \$.03 per \$100.00 of equalized, assessed real estate value? The sum collected will be expended solely for the purpose of acquiring farmland, open space, creating and maintaining recreational areas within the Township, and farmland and/or historic preservation. The annual revenue generated will be dedicated to the aforementioned goals.

INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT

Approval of this public question would permit the governing body of the Township of Oldmans to create an ordinance establishing the Oldmans Township "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund", which fund shall be used only for preservation of farmland, open space, creation and maintenance of recreation areas and/or for public historic preservation within Oldmans Township. It would further allow the Township of Oldmans to take advantage of available grants from the State Agriculture Development Committee. Additionally, funds could also be spent for the creation of greenways and trails to promote passive recreation opportunities for residents of Oldmans Township. If Approved by the majority of voters of the Township of Oldmans, the Oldmans Township Committee has the ability to create the Oldmans Township "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" to be dedicated with a maximum of up to \$.03 per \$100.00 of equalized, assessed property values. If such a tax is created, a home with an assessed value of \$100,000.00 would be taxed a maximum of an additional \$30.00 per year. NJDEP Green Acres programs and other area conservation organizations can assist the Township in acquiring farmland, open space and achieving public historic preservation and the funds could also be used for recreational projects and for their maintenance.
